## DAILY PRAYER CALENDAR

QUARTER 2 - 2026  
APRIL | MAY | JUNE

Take a moment to pray for Across Nigeria. Below is a prayer request for each day of the month.

**Day 1** - Please pray for our work in Maiduguri. Pray for our pastors and church families as they mourn those lost in the recent bombings; may they feel the Lord's presence and find safety.

**Day 2** - Pray for peace between the Fulani Muslims and Christian farmers in Northern Nigeria. The violence is continually increasing and many are being killed.

**Day 3** - Pray for Gambo's four brothers, new believers since earlier this year. Pray for their spiritual growth, their witness to others, and comfort as they mourn their brother's loss.

**Day 4** - Pray for our Fulani nomadic schools in Indofa and Buzi. Nomadic schools are particularly challenging to operate and manage. We need wisdom and discernment to keep these schools operating smoothly.

**Day 5** - Pray for the militants of the Islamic State of West Africa (ISWA). Ask that God would reveal Himself to them and that their hearts would be open to the gospel of Jesus Christ.

**Day 6** - Pray for our underground churches. Pray for safety for their members and that the Lord would continue to open the doors to allow us to plant more churches in high-risk areas.

**Day 7** - Pastor Justin Nenge is our northern operations director. Pray for protection and provision for him, his wife (Grace), and their three children.

**Day 8** - Pray for our pastors that God would grant them boldness and discernment as they lead their congregations in very difficult environments.

**Day 9** - Pray for our work in Jos following the Palm Sunday bombings that killed 28 and wounded 63. Pray for the safety of all Christians facing ongoing persecution and attacks.

**Day 10** - Pray for the two new nomadic schools in Layung and Lakkol. Pray that the children's hearts open to the Gospel and that they lead their families to Jesus.

**Day 11** - Pray for Pastor Timothy Gideon as he disciples new believers from Islamic backgrounds at our refugee facility. Ask for God's patience and wisdom as he navigates this challenge.

**Day 12** - Pray for our Fulani radio broadcast, reaching over 300,000 listeners. Ask God to open their hearts and provide opportunities to expand this ministry.

**Day 13** - Pray for Pastor George Kamalu, our southern operations director, as he oversees six churches and their pastors. Ask for God's wisdom and discernment in his leadership.

**Day 14** - Pray for our Hausa Bible Institute students to grow closer to God and mature in His Word and Spirit.

**Day 15** - Pray for the families of the four Across Nigeria personnel killed in recent attacks; may they experience the Lord's supernatural peace.

**Day 16** - Pray for Muhammed, a northern Nigerian chief's son who converted after a series of dreams. Pray for his continued growth in faith.

**Day 17** - Pray for our first school as it faces overcrowding. Ask that God provide the resources needed to expand our classrooms.

**Day 18** - Pray for our refugees: that we can expand our aid to provide safety and permanent housing. Above all, pray they find faith and supportive communities to begin their new lives.

**Day 19** - Pray for the Church in the United States. Ask that God would awaken the church to the spiritual battle against Christians in Nigeria and around the world.

**Day 20** - Pray for Habib Adamu. He manages our radio ministry in Northern Nigeria. Ask God to grant him strength and discernment to respond to those inquiring about the gospel of Jesus Christ.

**Day 21** - Pray for the 5 Across Nigeria personnel who were injured in the recent attacks.

**Day 22** - Pray that God would give wisdom to the members of Across Nigeria's board of directors.

**Day 23** - Pray for the Fulani people in Nigeria. Pray that God would open their hearts to the gospel of Jesus Christ.

**Day 24** - With over 100,000 Christians killed since 2009, Nigeria is the world's most dangerous place for believers. Please pray for all those facing persecution there.

**Day 25** - Pray for believers in the U.S., asking the Lord to show them how to support and engage with the persecuted church in Nigeria.

**Day 26** - Pray for Chief Alhaji Gambo of the Ruga Fulani community. Ask that God would open his heart to the Gospel and grant us opportunities to minister among his people.

**Day 27** - Pray for families who have lost loved ones to Muslim militant violence. Ask for God's peace and provision, and that their faith would remain unshaken.

**Day 28** - Pray for all Across Nigeria staff—teachers, pastors, and field directors, volunteers. Ask for their safety, wisdom, and discernment as the Lord uses them to spread His light and love.

**Day 29** - Pray for provision, asking that God would meet every need—great or small.

**Day 30** - Pray for the U.S. government, that leaders across all parties would recognize the persecution of Christians in Nigeria and find the boldness to take action.

**Day 31** - Pray that the Lord would open unreached and closed regions of Nigeria, allowing us to expand our work, serve the people, and share the Gospel.
